ARCH Hospice is only partially government funded, requiring more than \$850,000 annually in community support as well as the generosity of over 150 volunteers to provide our services to the community.

She challenged herself to cycle 100 KM and encouraged 100 participants to cycle alongside her! Her goal was to raise \$10,000 for a cause she is incredibly passionate about: end-of-life care. Her goal was quickly surpassed, and more than 120 riders came out to cycle in support of ARCH! It was incredible to see so many people of different ages and abilities ride together and challenge themselves to do something extraordinary! ## ABOUT ST. JOSEPH ISLAND

Many colourful stories, some legends, some historical facts, are told about beautiful St. Joseph Island. The most western part of the Manitoulin chain of islands, St. Joseph Island is located in the channel between Lakes Huron and Superior, located only 45 km east of Sault Ste. Marie.

In the spring, the Island comes to life with the flow of maple syrup that has made St. Joseph Island famous. Warmer weather also sees the return of boaters and avid fishers. In the fall, the maples on the Island turn brilliant colours ranging from bright red, to orange to yellow. Winter bustles carpets of snow on the snowmobile trail system.

St. Joseph Island is a hidden gem for cycling, one of the main reasons Julie chose to host the event there. It has tremendous appeal for cyclists due to its open country roads, beautiful scenic views of Lake Huron, and a variety of terrains for those looking to challenge themselves. The majority of the roads are surface-treated and traffic is typically minimal, creating the perfect roads for cycling!

The Bike Repair Hub located at the Richards Landing Marina is a newly built bike repair station. The Hub is equipped with a permanent air pump, bike stand and tools for minor repairs!
